The Legal Penal Satisfaction Truth

I God's Holy nature demands that sin be PUNISHED.

II Grace does not and cannot violate or suspend LAW

III The work of an Acceptable Substitute must be wholly and truly VOLUNTARY.

A. A surety must QUALIFY to serve

Same Nature, Free from Law, Freely Assumed (Voluntary)

(Surety: A prisoner who is held by one party to insure that another party will meet specified terms, One who provides a warrant or guarantee to another, A guarantee that an obligation will be met)

B. A surety must be LEGALLY accepted.
