He finished his Masters degree in Electrical Engineering through The Air Force Institute of Technology in 1990. Pastor Rice, after serving as a youth pastor at each air base where he was stationed for the past 20 years, surrendered to be a Preacher of the Gospel of Jesus Christ in June 1992. He has a Masters and PhD in Theological Studies from LBU.edu and has been Pastoring in Yates County, NY since April 1995. Since Feb 1998 he has been Pastoring Good Samaritan Baptist Church in Dresden New York. His staunch belief in the preserved accuracy of the inspired Scriptures and his rich background in the history of Bible believing Baptists makes his insights throughout this 14 day tour of Israel pointed and Biblical. If you have never visited Israel do not miss this opportunity to journal through these 14 days. If you have visited, this journal will take you back, and can bring you up on many things about Israel. If you plan on visiting Israel, do not go without first taking this 14 day journaling experience.

#### About the Subject Matter

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#### **Dedication**

I wanted to go to Israel ever since 1960 when I was saved and attended Marian Clark's Sunday School class at Fellowship Baptist Church, Gang Mills NY. I listened to him talk about the places where Jesus walked as if he had been there. I do not know that he had, but the pictures that he painted in my mind's eye week after week, and God's promises that he taught in that Jr. boys class assured me that I would one day stand with my Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, on the Mount of Olives and see Jerusalem with him as the King of kings and Lord of lords. I still will, but to visit there in the flesh was a dream I inherited from my Sunday School training and my father, Levi Rice. Since his salvation in the same Church in 1958, Dad always wanted to go to Israel, to actually see Jerusalem, and he had tickets in hand after his second by pass surgery. His heart was weak, but I had told him that to go and even to die in the land, would be better than to forgo such a dream. I was disappointed that his doctor and others, concerned for his heart, talked him out of his 10 day trip to the Holy Land. He canceled his opportunity and died without visiting Israel.

When the opportunity came for Bev and I to go on a 10 day Pastor Familiarization Tour it was financially impossible because we had just purchased tickets for our 10 day trip to Cajamarca, Peru, where our son Shane was ministering as a missionary. Impossible or no, the journal of that trip to the Holy Land was published. Then in July of 2022 another series of health and financial miracles brought us to sign up for another pilgrimage to Israel through Vision Baptist College of Solid Rock Baptist Church, Berlin NJ, where our grand children attended. They would escort us to Israel on Oct 30<sup>th</sup> through Nov 10<sup>th</sup> 2022, and our son Shane & Kathy Rice would join us. At the last minute or grandson Micah also got to join us on that trip. God is good, all the time. But then we had also promised our friend Pastor Lee Pickett that we would tour Israel with them when he arranged his tour, he did that on March 16-30, 2023, just three months after our return. God marvelously provided that we could keep our promise. This Half Shekel 2023 Journal Book is likewise dedicated to Misty, Kassandra, Rachael, Rebekah, Moriah, Micah, Alexus, Charity, Lucas, Parker and Christina Rice, our 11 grand children, with the expectation that they too, one day, will get to walk where Jesus walked, and that they too, will one day stand on the Mount of Olives with their Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.

# Full Trip Itinerary

(As presented in the original brochure)

Day 1 -Thursday, March 16 NEWARK Departure from Newark flying non-stop on El Al Israel Airlines departing Newark at 9:00pm from Terminal #3,

#### Day 2 - Friday, March 17 TEL AVIVI JAFFA

Arrive in Tel Aviv at 1:50pm where our tour guide will meet us. We begin our tour in Jaffa affording us a breathtaking view of the city of Tel Aviv. At this picturesque port city of winding alleys, art galleries and crafts boutiques, King Solomon had the cedars of Lebanon rafted for the building of the 1<sup>st</sup> Temple in Jerusalem. You will view the spot of the House of Simon the Tanner. Jonah departed from Joppa (Jonah 1:3) to Tarshish, Transfer to our hotel in Tel Aviv for check-in, Balance of day at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the Grand Beach Hotel, Tel Aviv

#### Day 3 - Sat, March 18 CAESAREA/MT.CARMEL/ MEGIDDO-

We drive north along the Plain of Sharon, the Mediterranean and the old coastal road- the Via Maris

that linked Egypt and Babylon as we journey towards Galilee. We stop at Caesarea the incredible fortress city built by King Herod the Great. Here, Pontius Pilate had his base; 'where Comelius lived and was baptized (Acts 10); where Paul embarked to Tarsus (Acts 9:30) and where Philip preached (Acts 8:40). Visit the Roman Theatre, the Hippodrome, and the Crusader City and Aqueduct. We then travel north towards Haifa and ascend Mt. Carmel the site where the prophet Elijah fought the 400 false prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18:30). We will stop for an incredible panoramic view of Haifa and the Bahai Gardens. We turn inland and proceed to Megiddo, one of King Solomon's walled fortified cities (1 Kings 9:15; 10:26), with ruins of 20 levels of civilization. From here the Books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as we read about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the Plains of Jezreel. Finish the day at Mt Arbel which stands sharply and prominently over your first view of the Sea of Galilee. The 'graceful stature and steep slopes, particularly on the easter side, provide magical views across the Sea of Galilee and beyond, to the Golan Heights. Dinner and overnight at Lake House Hotel, Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee

#### Day 4 - Sunday, March 19 JESUS MINISTRY IN THE GALILEE

After breakfast, we will depart our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee to Kibbutz Ginossar to visit the museum showing an ancient boat that sailed on the Sea of Galilee from the time of Jesus. Continue to Capernaum, the centre of Jesus' Galilean ministry and the site of many of His miracles (Mark 2:4; Matthew 8:5-17). We will see the remains of Peter's house and the synagogue site where Jesus taught and worshipped (Mark 1:21; Luke 4:31). Continue to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered what is perhaps the most famous sermon ever preached "The Sermon On The Mount" (Matt.5). We will then proceed to the site of the city of Korazim (Matthew 11:20-24) where there are the remains of a First Century Synagogue where Jesus frequently ministered. Dinner and overnight at Lake House Hotel, Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee

#### Day 5 - Monday, Mareh 20 GALILEE/GOLAN HEIGHTS

We start the day at Hazor one of the horse chariot cities from the time of King Solomon. Continue to Tel Dan to see the ruins from Abraham's time and the Dan Spring, which is a source of the Jordan River. Continue to the Banias, one of the sources of the Jordan River and the site of ancient "Caesarea Philipi", where Peter made the confession of faith in Christ (Mat; 16:16). Drive to the Golan Heights and the foot of Mt. Hermon the highest mountain in Israel and have a panoramic view of the corner of Israel, Syria and Jordan from Mt. Bental. Visit Kursi the place where a man was healed from demons. (Luke 8:26-39). Dinner and overnight at Lake House Hotel, Tiberias on the Sea of Galilee

#### Day 6 - Tuesday, March 21 NAZARETH BEIT SHEAN / JERUSALEM

We start the day at Cana of Galilee where Jesus performed his first miracle turning water into wine at the wedding (John 2:1-11). Continue to Nazareth, the boyhood town of Jesus. We will visit Nazareth Village depicting a village from the time of Jesus. Stop at Mt. Precipice for a magnificent view of the Valley of Armageddon before proceeding to Naim where a boy was raised from the dead. (Luke 7:11-17). Drive to Harod Spring the site of the Biblical Battle from the time of Gideon, We continue southward to Beit Shean, where we will walk through the incredible excavations of the largest ongoing archaeological dig in the land of Israel with its Roman theatre, colonnaded Roman streets, mosaics and Roman bathhouses. It is also the city where the bodies of King Saul and his sons where nailed to the walls by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10). We then drive through the lush Jordan Valley, where the desert now blooms with flowers and vegetation of every description (Isaiah 35:1-2). Stop at the Jordan River where Elijah stopped before ascending up the Judean Wilderness to the Golden City of Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem at the Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem

#### Day 7 - Wednesday, March 22 OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM

We will drive to the top of the Mount of Olives, for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Tracing the footsteps of Jesus, we will stroll down the Palm Sunday route on the Mount of Olives to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations, We drive across the Kidron Valley, past the Tombs of Absalom, Zechariah and James to Mt Zion to visit the traditional site of the Upper Room (Room of the Last Supper), King David's Tomb, and the Church of St. Peter's in Gallicantu, built on top of the high priest Caiphas' house. We walk to the Zion Gate and enter the Old City of Jerusalem to the Jewish Quarter. Walk along the Romar/Byzantine Street called the Cardo to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest. We continue our walk along the Via Dolorosa to visit the Pools of Bethesda, St. Anne's Church and Pilate's Judgment Hall.

Walk through the Old City alleyways and exit from the Jaffa Gate where our bus will be waiting for us. Drive to the Garden Tomb or Gordon's Calvary for a communion service. Dinner and overnight at the Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem

#### Day 8 - Thursday, March 23 JERUSALEM

We start the day in the Jewish Quarter of the Old City for a visit to the Davidson Center and the Archaeological Park around the southern wall excavations. We visit the City of David excavations once the capital of the Israeli Kingdom under King David. Explore the excavations and learn about Jerusalem's water supply in ancient times, See the Pool of Siloam and the Hezekiah's Tunnel. Drive to Yad Vashem, the national Holocaust Memorial and Museum for an emotional visit. We continue to the Israel Museum to visit the Model of Jerusalem from the Second Temple Period as it looked from the time of Jesus. We will stop next at the Knesset, Israel's Parliament to take a picture of the Menorah, Israel's national symbol. Dinner and overnight at the Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem.

#### Day 9 - Friday, March 24 VALLEY OF ELAH/ NEOT KEDUMIM

Drive to the Valley of Elah to see where the battle of David and Goliath took place. Continue to Beit Shemesh to read from 1 Samuel 6:1-21. Visit the Valley of Aijalon (Joshua 10:1-15). Continue to Neot Kedumim- the only Biblical Landscape Reserve in the world, where you can see and experience the Land of the Bible as it was during the time of the bible. Drive to Modi'in the birth place of the Maccabi's. Dinner and overnight at the Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem

#### Day 10 - Saturday, March 25 JERUSALEM

Today is a free day in Jerusalem to enjoy enjoying last minute shopping in the Old City Bazaars or v has to offer. Dinner and overnight at the Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem 1g the many museums that Jerusalem

#### Day 11 - Sunday, March 26 QUMRAN/ MASADA/ DEAD SEA

Drive to Qumran to see the caves where a young shepherd boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls in 1947. We stop at Ein Gedi Oasis t6 read scripture where David fled Saul. Continue south to Masada and ascend by cable car to the summit of this magnificent fortress built by, King Herod the Great and the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots. We drive to our hotel and the balance of the day for a chance to "float" i the saltiest body of water in the world or usc the hotel's spa. Dinner and overnight at the David Hotel, Dead Sea

#### Day 12 - Monday, March 27 DEAD SEA/ TIMNA NATIONAL PARK/ EILAT

Depart in the late morning and drive south through the Arava Valley at to see the Wilderness come to bloom, Isaiah 35:1-10. Continue to the Timna National Park to see the King Solomon Pillars and the Tabernacle in Wilderness (Exodus 40). Dinner and overnight at the Isrotel Yam Suf Hotel, Eilat

#### Day 13 - Tuesday, March 28 EILAT

Today is a free day in Eilat to enjoy this resort town on the Red Sea, Perhaps go swimming or relaxing at your hotel swimming pool or on the beach, snorkeling or scuba diving. You can visit the world famous Underwater Observatory to see the coral and tropical fish in their natural environment. Dinner and overnight at the Isrotel Yam Suf Hotel, Eilat

#### Day 14 - Wednesday. March 29 NEGEV/BEER SHEVA/ TEL AVIV.

Depart Eilat and drive through the Negev and the moon like landscape of the Ramon Crater. Stop for a visit to Avdat and see the remains from the Roman period and 5" century Byzantine churches. Continue to Tel Beer-Sheva (Genesis 21:22-34) now the capital of the Negev before arriving to Tel Aviv for check-in at the Grand Beach Hotel. Dinner at the Grand Beach Hotel, Tel Aviv before transferring to the airport for our flight home.

#### Day 15 - Thursday, March 30 NEWARK

Depart Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport on El Al Israel Airlines at 12:30am arriving in Newark at 5:15am.

#### **Preface**

During my 48 years as a born again Christian I have visited Israel countless times through the slides and stories of others, now Bev and I would visit it in person, again. I would be remiss if I did not capture every piece of information, every sight, every thought and emotion in a journal. My slightly honed writing skills and copious note taking experience would be challenged beyond capability as information, sights, thoughts and emotions poured out of every day, every hour, yeah every minute of these fourteen days in Israel. In the months prior to departure we had returned from a ten day Israel Pilgrimage, and I was busily journaling that experience. I had learned much about the required note taking that would build a journal, but was still barely up to the task. I wish it were complete and more detailed in capturing every piece of information, every Scripture reference, sight, thought, and emotion of this trip. Alas, I pray it is but a taste of an adventure that will whet appetites for growth into the knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ and His Holy Bible.

The journal itself is made up of thirty Half Shekel Journals which were sent out for review over the weeks since our March 2023 trip. Through these Half Shekel Journals each event of our adventure was captured and recorded. Much more research into every site and fact is want to be done, and easily accomplished with the vast capabilities of the internet search engines. This journal is but a step towards the research which is to consume a Christian's life; growing in the knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. It is a first step that can change forever how you read your Bible, set your desire on the return of the Lord Jesus Christ, and get busy in growth and witnessing. It is a step that will cause one to long for their trip to Israel, whether it be a first, once in a lifetime visit, a revisit, or the visit where we will stand together with the Lord Jesus Christ on the Mount of Olives. Every Born-Again Christian will eventually visit Israel.

Why the Half Shekel? ... The shekel is the base unit of Israeli money like the dollar is ours. With their economy as it is, it exchanges for one of our quarters, although it is the size of our nickel. The half shekel is twice as large as a shekel, but half its worth, about 12 1/2 cents or 1 US once-upon-a-time 'bit'. We called these Half-Shekel Journals because it is twice as large but half the worth of the real thing, OR it represents my little 'bit' of info, OR it cost me a half shekel to get it printed, OR, since a cup of Aroma Coffee In Israel cost 16 shekels, the half shekel is almost as worthless as our 2 cents, and the journal is my 2 cents.

If you have never asked and received the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour and Lord of your soul, my prayer is that your reading this journal and exploring further the truths of His precious Word, the Holy Bible will lead you to a place where you will. "For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. … He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him. … 24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life" (Jn.3:17,18,36, 5:24).

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
