There are three (3) kinds of people in the world: Matt.7:13-14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

UNSAVED PEOPLE For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

SAVED PEOPLE Walking in the Spirit Rom.8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

SAVED PEOPLE NOT Walking in the Spirit i.e. Walking the OLD paths Eph.2:2-3 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

Which are you? ANYONE can switch to the middle category, Saved and Walking in the Spirit, by one meaningful PRAYER. Rom. 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. ... 1John.1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. ... He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
- Joh 5:24 Verily, Verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

- Ro 5:8,12,18 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us ... 12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: ... 18 Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.
- Ro 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Ro 10:9-10, 13 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. ... For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

- Five Keys for SAVED PEOPLE Walking in the Spirit 1st Get to first base: ANYONE can get to the category, Saved and Walking in the Spirit, by one meaningful PRAYER. Rom.10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. ... 1John.1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Love The Lord Mr 12:30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.
- Do all to his glory 1Co 10:31 Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.
- Focus on the Great Change 2Cor.5:17,18,20 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; ... Now then we are ambassadors for Christ,
- Focus on a Renewed Mind Phil.4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.
- Unclean touching clean, is UNCLEAN Haggai 2:12-13 If one bear holy flesh in the skirt of his garment, and with his skirt do touch bread, or pottage, or wine, or oil, or any meat, shall it be holy? And the priests answered and said, No. Then said Haggai, If one that is unclean by a dead body touch any of these, shall it be unclean? And the priests answered and said, It shall be unclean.




