#### Msg #2301 Start 2023 Out Right

What The Bible Savs Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice The Apostle Paul's heart is on display in the first verse of Philippians 4. It makes his charge to the precious saints of Philippi weigh more as we take our first steps into a brand new year. "Stand fast in the Lord, my dearly beloved" (Phil.4:1b). We do not know what will hit us in a year, but God does and he knows, if we will stand fast in him, he will take care of whatever hits us. "Be of the same mind in the Lord" (vr.2). Stand together. In perilous times, when our ranks shrink and persecutions arise, when our own government officials promote immorality and defy godliness, Christians, genuine Bible believing ones, dare not be divided, there is a cause."I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, ..." (vr.3). Stand behind those preaching the genuine, glorious gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, and "If any man preach any other gospel unto you than ye have received, let him be accursed" (Gal.1:8,9). True yokefellow know what secured their soul's salvation; it was not penance, baptisms, good works or religion, it is the blood of Christ. Stand fast, stand together, and stand behind the preaching of that gospel.

We aptly begin this year on the first day of the week, Sunday, when God tells us he made this whole time-space-matter continuum and said, "Let there be light" (Gen.1:1-5). On Monday He divided the space into heaven and a ball of water (vr.6-8); on Tuesday he made dry land appear and filled it with plants (vr.9-13); on Wednesday He made sun, moon and stars (vr.14-19); on Thursday He made fish and fowl (vr.20-23); and on Friday God made the living creatures and said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness" ... #### Msg #2302 Power for Christian Living

What The Bible Savs Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice The Apostle Paul writes a powerful and organized letter to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi. The adversity lining up against Christianity for 2023 requires that his remnant be well grounded in their Lord's instruction. Dr. McGee alliterates Paul's outline by chapter as Philosophy, Pattern, Prize, and Power of Christian living. The all important power, he says, comes from a Source (4:1-4), a Secret (vr.5-7), a Sanctuary (vr.8-9), and a Satisfaction (vr.10-23). The source of power is the joy that comes from standing fast, standing together, and standing behind the laborers. The secret of power is prayer and supplications with thanksgiving. The sanctuary holding that power for Christian living is his temple. In the OT God built a temple for his people, in the NT he builds a People for his temple. "What? Know ve not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you?" (1Cor.6:19).

A Christian must keep the temple holy and sanctified. We live in a vile and filthy society. Satan is using every avenue he can to control and destroy mankind and that can put some "stinkingthinking" in even a Christian's mind. His drive for a socialist/communist "utopia" invades the unregenerate mind like a plague. People all around us are surrendered to it as never before. Focus the renewing or your mind to make it God's sanctuary. "*Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God?*"(1Cor.6:9). #### Msg #2303 True, Honest, and Just

What The Bible Savs Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice Christians are admonished to keep our minds stayed on things that are true, things that are honest, and things that are just (Phil.4:8). We presently live in a world that is diametrically opposed to all three of these virtues. A radical faction is in majority control of our government, and its corruption is anchored and built on lies. dishonesty, and injustice. I pray they will be over-turned, but find no reason to put trust in a voting booth. God described Judah when she was in a similar straight, "Judgment is turned away backward, and *justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity* cannot enter" (Isa.59:14). Equity is "impartial distribution of justice; treating a person according to justice and reason." (Noah Webster 1828). To the Marxist socialist that is now in control, "equity" has nothing to do with justice, and now means "everyone is provided what they need to reach an equal outcome."

The prophet continues, "Yea, truth faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the Lord saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment" (Isa.59:15). The prophet goes on, "According to their deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to his adversaries, recompense to his enemies" (59:18). The pure gold that covered all the shittim wood of the ark of the covenant is its first mention. The wood represents the frail, flawed, flesh of humanity, ugly in character and in name. Modernists, change God's word to try and make that shittim wood some beautiful, aromatic, acacia wood, but the original Bible wording is correct. The pure gold, a precious metal that does not tarnish, represents the pure righteousness of a holy God. Pure gold righteousness of God covered all shittim wood of the tabernacle. Purity in the Old-Testament further applies to seed and sacrifice, incense and frankincense, water and the Word. Purity in the New-Testament begins with "Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God", and goes on to robes of pure white linen, of being pure through the Word, of charity out of a pure heart, and of having a pure conscious. When David heard that King Saul was dead, he could have said a lot about Saul's last ten years. He did not. He eulogized him, thinking only on whatsoever things are good. "*Saul and Jonathan were lovely and pleasant in their lives*" (2Sam.1:23, cf 17–27). Keep your focus right, and rejoice.

#### Msg #2305 How to Abide in Him

"And now, little children, abide in him" (1Jn.2:28). Pastor Thomas says John writes an organized chapter to explain how to abide in him. John explains, "He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also to walk, even as he walked" (2:6). Jesus walked with love, "and he loved them onto the end" (Jn.13:1); he walked with forgiveness, "father, forgive them" (Lk.23:34); and he walked in ministry, "the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister" (Mk.10:45). Jesus said, "Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me" (Matt.11:29). Then walk that way.

John goes on, "*He that loveth his brother abideth in the light*"(1Jn.2:10). When we abide in him, we abide in light. He is light (Jn.1:9). One could ask the Good Samaritan, "Who is my brother?" (Lk.10); he is more than the one we sit beside in church.

John says, "*He that doeth the will of God abideth forever*" (1Jn.2:17b). Do his will, to abide in him. Romans 12:1-2 tells how to "*prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*" Ephesians 5:15 says do it circumspectly, 1Thes.4:3 without fornication, and 5:18 with thanks. Jn.7:17 says do it, to know it! And Jesus said, "*If you know these things, happy are ye if you do them*" (Jn.13:17).

John further says, "*Let that therefore abide in you which ye have heard from the beginning*" (1Jn.2:24a). Keep the word, let it never depart from your mouth (Josh.1:8). Read it (Rev.1:3); all of it (2Tim.3:15–17). Abide in him by keeping his Word.

Lastly, John says to abide in him, hear the voice of his Holy Spirit. "*The anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you*" (1Jn.2:27). He will teach you all things. "*And now, little children, abide in him*" (2:28).

#### Msg #2306 Contentment With His Glory

What The Bible Says Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice The letter to the Philippians shows the power source for living a joyful Christian life. "*I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therein to be content*" (Phil.4:11). This is not a natural reaction, it is a learned behavior. Paul already spoke of the philosophy, the pattern, and the price of Christian living and shows its power to be in our, stand (4:1-4), prayer life (4:5–7), sanctified mind (4:8–9), and now, our contentment in where we are at, and what we are facing (4:11–13). "*I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need*" (4:12).

Being content, even in the most trying of circumstances, acknowledges that God knows what he is doing, and that I trust him. The Bible has many examples where God allows, or leads, his followers into impossible circumstances. It's for his glory, honor and/or recognition. Twice the disciples were led into a boat (Matt.8:22-23,14:22); both times they ended up in a great storm (8:24,14:24), and both times Jesus was gloriously magnified (8:26– 27,14:25).

The Israelites were led into what Pastor Young called a "culdesac." There was no place to turn. "And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, … The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace. … And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD" (Exod.14:13–14, 18).

Learn to be content. Don't pray, "Lord get me out of this circumstance!" but pray, "Lord be magnified in this circumstance." Whether you are "jammed up" because of your own blunder, or in his leading, seek his glory. The tougher the circumstance, the greater his glory.

"For the ways of man are before the eyes of the LORD, and he pondereth all his goings. … the LORD pondereth the hearts." (Pr.5:21, 21:2). So we should be significant to our "significant-other". "Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. ..25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church" (Eph 5:22,25).

We are secure in God. "... *He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee*" (Heb.13:5, cf Jn.14:3,Ps.37:25,Lu.12:24). Review and renew those promises this Valentine's Day.

Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore will not we fear, ... " The 46<sup>th</sup> Psalm is a three "Selah" Psalm that describes a Christian's Refuge, vr.1-3,7; God's upcoming River, vr.4-5; the heathen's Rage, vr.6a; the LORD's Response, vr.6b-9: and a commanded *Reaction* from believers, vr.10-11. "The State of the Union Address" displayed a disunion wherein half of our congressmen rallied behind the queer Marxist socialist takeover promoted by the progressives allied with big tech, education, and Satan himself. Banning fossil-fuels will NOT make America great OR save the world. There is no telling how bad this will get, ... unless you have a King-James-Bible. "Though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea ... ", even then, we have a refuge and are not to fear. The River that "shall make glad the city of God" is more completely described in Ezekiel 47, and it provides life to the earth after Armageddon. The heathen's Rage is described in Psalm 2, wherein God's reaction is given in Ps.2:4. I have found their mention helpful to us old crusty converts as well. If you were never a new convert to Christ, I'll have to say you are not a convert at all, and Jesus said, "Verily I say onto you, Except ye be converted,... Ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven" (Matt.18:3). Once in the kingdom of heaven one should regularly read their Bible. It was the quick and powerful, inspired Word that brought you to conversion, keep reading (2Tim.2:15, 3:15–17, Heb.4:12). Second, one should pray, supplicate, and give thanks daily (Phil.4:6-7). Your call to God in prayer secured your conversion (Rom.10:9-10), keep talking to him. Third, you should tell someone what happened on this day that you were converted to Christ. Converts are to be his witnesses (Jn.20:21, Acts1:8, Isa.43:10,12,44:8). Fourth, a true convert needs to gather with other true converts. We edify one another, and need to be in a Bible believing, Bible preaching, Biblically functioning church (Heb.10:23-25). Fifth a true convert is to follow the Lord in public believers baptism, and then regularly be present at the Lord's table to publicly observe communion. These are two ordinances of the local church. They are not sacraments, there is no magical or mystical aspect to these ordinances, they are a convert's initial public admission, before God and everybody, that they are born-again, blood-bought, redeemed to God through Christ, converts. And the Lord's table observance is a public testimony declaring, I am still in perfect communion with my Lord and Savior, and in sweet communion with these believers, in this local church. Both baptism and communion are ordinances administered by the local Bible believing church. These are basics.

#### Msg #2310 Don't Give Until it Hurts

What The Bible Says Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice With all the prosperity gospel shysters out there, an honest preacher of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ might tip toe around the church offering plate, but the Apostle Paul nails it for the church of God at Corinth. He begins 2Cor.8 with the grace of God that produced abounding liberality in the churches of Macedonia. Recall Paul's Macedonian call (Acts.16:9), his reception at Philippi (vr.12), his first European convert, Lydia (vr.14-15), his encounter with a Philippian Jailer (vr.31), and the rapid birth of a church at Thessalonica (17:1-3). These fledgling, on fire churches of Macedonia are held up, to one of the most crusty, carnal churches of the NT, as a superb example of givers. We should learn the lesson.

Evangelist Harold Boyd taught, "God does not ask us to take up offerings to raise money, he does it to raise children." "You can give without loving, but you cannot love without giving." "If God does not get ahold of your wallet, he will not get ahold of your will." "Don't give until it hurts, give until it feels good." "Grace giving will never bring you to the law, but it will bring you to the cross." "Real prosperity, with real faith, is the ability to tap into God's resources to get what you need to meet the needs of others, … God has already promised to meet your needs." "Tithing is a debt you owe, faith promise giving is a seed you sow."

All these well thought out pithy verses are in the margin of my Bible around 2Cor.8 and 9. At our annual Faith Promise Missions Giving Conferences, Brother Boyd would say, "Pastor Rice, get a pencil, I am going to give you something worth writing down." There are more. These chapters to Corinth are a beacon of abounding liberality.

Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice While Pastor Rice and Bev are touring Israel with Pastor Lee

Pickett from March  $16^{th}$  – March  $31^{st}$ , here is an entry from their journal of last years trip: (view the whole journal by visiting our website and clicking "Journaling a Preacher's Pilgrimage to Israel")

From Half Shekle Journal Entry #01: While Pastor Rice tours Israel here is an entry from last years trip: Our bus ride toward the Temple Mount did not interrupt our worship. "Lord, let the awe of being in your Jerusalem, this holy city of Zion, never lessen in me." Eiad's miracle maneuvering of a 40 foot Irizar i6S bus through the narrow streets of Jerusalem was repeatedly interrupted with our guide Joe's reports that on the right you can see the Kidron Valley<sup>1</sup> and the walled up Eastern Gate, ... don't forget them as we will talk more of them shortly; on the left you see the tombs that line the Mount of Olives, remember them we will visit Gethsemane Today. ...

Joe again tries to catch up on the sites rapidly passing our bus windows. Much needs to be said here about the inferno of the old Valley of Hinnom<sup>2</sup> that we passed, and the City of David, that we will visit. I couldn't capture all that swept by our bus windows, but alas we careened to a halt somewhere near the Dung Gate. Joe said he probably did not need to expound how this gate got its name. Here we would enter and make our way toward the Temple Mount.

The hatred that Muslims have for the Holy Bible, for God's chosen nation Israel, and the people of the book, i.e. Bible believing Christians, would be on full display as we entered the Muslim controlled Temple Mount. We were instructed to leave all Bibles and Christian literature on the bus, and to conceal all "religious" jewelry and talk, none would be allowed in the Temple Mount area. I even left my walking stick (that the VA calls my cane) behind because it was inscribed with, "In the beginning God" in both

English and Hebrew ( ברא אלהים the first three words of the Hebrew Bible). This was to be an awesome incursion into the Temple Mount area of the Mount Moriah of Bible times. It is curious that Israel hating, Jehovah hating Muslims are in control of the whole Temple Mount area. In a brief explanation Joe implied that in order to ward off WWIII, the area was gingerly handed back<sup>3</sup> to them after the whole city of Jerusalem was conquered during the Six Day War<sup>4</sup>. ...

Lots of drama unfolded at the checkpoint as they searched us to ensure we were not carrying any contraband literature, and god forbid any Holy Bibles. It was quite like Satan himself was in full control of who and what got into this temple mount area.

Fifty born-again believers, nine of them Pastors and Preachers of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ got in just the same, and looked in amazement at the unholy Muslim mosque that stood before us. "O God, the heathen are come into thine inheritance; thy holy temple have they defiled; they have laid Jerusalem on heaps" (Ps.79:1).

From Half Shekle Journal Entry #02: Being careful about who was listening in, (on the very restrictive, Muslim controlled Temple Mount) Pastor Charlie continues. Another page of HisStory was written beneath this Temple Mount we are standing on. Solomon built the first temple on this very spot. Pastor continued to carefully expound God's documentation about Mount Moriah. King David accumulated the resources and designs for his son's miraculous construction of the temple. No chisel or hammer sounded on this site during the whole seven year construction (1Kng.6:7,38). But the Psalmists sure sounded out a lot about Solomon's Temple that stood here. Read here from Psalm.<sup>5</sup>

It is hard to envision Solomon's temple as we stand here on a huge platform built by King Herod. The foot print of Solomon's temple is dwarfed by the platform that Herod built. Solomon's temple was glorious just the same. The Bible gives the dimensions for artist to imagine the pictures shown. There are also the models seen at the Israeli Museum.

Solomon's temple was gutted when Nebuchadnezzar ransacked the city in 606 BC (2Chr.36:6, 2Kng.24:14) and then completely destroyed when he came back in 595 BC (2Chr.36:13-21, 2Kng.25:1-17). Israel was thrust into the Babylonian captivity for 70 years as God said (2Chr,36:21, Jer.25,27,29), and, consequently, the Jews returned exactly 70 years after 606, in 536 BC (Ezra 1:1-4), and the rebuilt temple was finished twenty years later in 515 BC (Ezra 6:15)<sup>6</sup>. God runs a pretty exacting calendar.

Standing on Mount Moriah and reviewing events the Bible records 2,600 years ago added a depth to our worship here. Noah Webster defines a "pilgrimage" as "a long journey, particularly a journey to someplace deemed sacred and venerable (worthy of reverence), in order to pay devotion to relics of some deceased saint." We were not here for deceased saints, but for a living Savior. This was a pilgrimage just the same, and God said that this place where we stood was indeed sacred. The slides shown here are from a Temple History presentation assembled by the author in 2015.

Pastor Charlie pulled us from 600 BC back to the present, Look at this great platform that Herod built, that dome and the mosque are each laden with demonic symbols and represent Satan's presence here, but look back to visualize the temple that stood on this ground. Herod's temple, the temple where Jesus overthrew the tables of the money changers, stood right here. Pastor laid before us the very presence of Jesus in this place; and the authority he always displayed with his presence in this temple. Always? Yes always! It was as if he owned the place.

From Half Shekle Journal Entry #03: As we gathered at the north end of the Temple Mount our guide Joe, and then our guide, Pastor Charlie, addressed what was once standing in the empty lot before us. To address Jerusalem's vulnerability from the north a citadel was placed on a rocky plateau just outside the north west corner of the Temple Area. "The fortress served as a headquarters for the Roman army in Jerusalem... The close proximity of its high towers to the temple complex enabled Roman guards to keep watch on any disturbances that developed. Herod had built underground passage ways that allowed Roman detachments to enter the compound if deemed necessary."<sup>7</sup>

This fortress was used for the Roman's judgment hall and Mark 15:16 says of Christ on trial, "*And the soldiers lead him away into the hall, called Praetorium; and they called together the whole band.*" An old Arabic proverb says, "He that speaks well turns ears into eyes." As Pastor Charlie spoke we could see the Roman Praetorium<sup>8</sup> standing in the open lot before us. We could see Jesus in the hands of the mocking soldiers; we could hear Pontius Pilot say to the crowd, "*What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ* (Messiah)? *They all say unto him, Let him be crucified*" (Mat.27:22).

It only took a moment really; mere minutes of our time standing at the north end of the Temple Mount. The Muslims had made sure that we had no Bibles to open. Our guide Joe, with just a few worded brushstrokes had painted the towers of a Roman citadel, filled with soldiers, and housing a judgment hall called Praetorium.

Our guide Pastor Chalie had made that hall echo with God's word, Pontius Pilot's words, and soldiers with a purple robe and crown of thorns. Our guide, the Holy Spirit of God now flooded my mind with holy words: *"For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him"* (2Cor.5:20). (Ref also Isa.53:6, Jhn.3:17-18, 36,5:24). It is a horrible thing that man did in that judgment hall, that Praetorium that once stood only a few feet from where we now listened to Pastor Charlie.

The law was given in 1492 BC and for 1,500 years man was tried and tested for his ability to keep that law. He was supposed, by keeping the law, to come through the dark veil and stand in the presence of a holy God. He failed, man was, and is incapable of keeping God's law, incapable of standing in God's presence through law. In this judgment hall, the verdict for man is forever in; here man condemned the only begotten Son of God to death on a cruel cross. That guilty verdict for man cries out, "the heart of man is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked..." (Jer.17:9). ... "As it is written there is none righteous, no, not one: there is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. ... For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God" (Rom.3:10-11, 23). ...

The trial whereby man must keep the law of God is past. That dispensation, or test of stewardship, is ended, that case cannot be reopened by any religion. A new dispensation is now opened and springs on the world as a new dawn. *"For by grace are ye saved through faith"* (Eph.2:8-9, 7).... We somberly walked by the Praetorium which stood in our minds eye, and began our departure from the Temple Mount. It is a marvelous thing to be saved by grace.

#### Msg #2314 Palm Sunday Gethsemane Wednesday

What The Bible Savs Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice The Gospel of Matthew constitutes an introduction to the New Testament and the new covenant (Jer.31:31, Heb.8:8,13, 12:24). Consequently, it more vividly portrays the offering of the Kingdom of Heaven to the Jews, and their consequential rejection of their Messiah. The fourth gospel clarifies, "He came unto his own, and his own received him not" (Jn.1:11). The Palm Sunday reception of Jesus into Jerusalem, and his subsequent three days of teaching in the temple before his crucifixion, are thus the focus of Matthew 21 thru 25. John 12 reveals that six days before the 14<sup>th</sup> of Abib Passover (Ex.13:4), Jesus was in Betheny with Mary, Martha, and Lazarus; it was the 8<sup>th</sup>. On Sabbath the 9<sup>th</sup> the chief priests consulted (Jn.12.10), and on Sunday, the 10<sup>th</sup> of Abib, Jesus was triumphantly escorted into Jerusalem, on the day that the Passover lamb was selected and separated from the flock according to Exodus 12:3. In Matt.21:10 "all the city was moved, saying, Who is this?" and in verse 11, where they should have announced "He is the Messiah, the Son of the Living God!"(Mt.16:16) they denied him saying, "This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee." Even today, if you cannot make that distinction, you cannot be saved from condemnation, you cannot enter the kingdom of God. (Jn,3:17-18). So Jesus first goes into the temple overthrowing money changers, then leaves for Bethany (Mt.21:17). The next day, Monday, while coming to the city early in order to teach all day (Lu.19:47,22:53), he curses a fig tree (21:18-19), and clears out the money changers again (Mrk.11:14-16). On Tuesday early, on his way to teach at the temple (Lu.21:37-38), they find the fig tree withered; Jesus teaches about faith (Mt.21:21-22). If you are not in position, God can save anybody: get in! (Eph2:1– 10). For those IN Christ, concerning our walk and service, Paul beseeches us to walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called. In Christ, you have a new "vocation", an occupation, an employment, a trade, a profession; you are a convert, a believer, a disciple, a Christian. Walk worthy of your vocation!

In the Bible election and callings have to do with service not salvation. There's a corporate calling for all to be saved, but once you are "IN" the Elect-One, you are elect and called to service, it's a vocation! The esteemed, John Calvin never got this right, and Calvinists are forever bungling around in error. So, how does a "Christian" (one IN-Christ, who acts like, looks like, smells like, talks like, thinks like, and reacts like Christ) how does he walk? "With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love" (Eph.4:2). But wait, there's more: "Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace"(vr.3). An endeavor is an effort, an attempt, a labor towards a goal. Unity will be an endeavoring! The modernist who said, "Don't let doctrine divide us, let the 'spirit' unite us," mucked up a lot of Christian walk. Paul, here, gives seven unities to be kept in the bond of peace. You are remiss to throw them all out for some dangerous, charismatic little "s" "spirit." All four attitudes of vr.2 need analyzed in my life, and all seven unities of vr.4-6 need bolstered with good doctrine. Let's get cracken.

The widow woman first lashed out at Elijah (vr.18). Elijah took the child to his room and privately lashed out at God (vr.20). Be sensitive to your conduct when a great fiery trial lands in your life. We can get better or we can, all too quickly, get bitter. The Bible is written so you'll know better than getting bitter. In this great trial Elijah prayed privately, sincerely, boldly, and specifically, and God answered. These busiest servants of God came through the refining trial and it produced life more abundant; it produced joy unspeakable and full of glory; it produced faith; it produced proof of a prophet's credentials; and it produced proof of the Word of God. Refining trials are precious and produce spiritual maturity in the spiritually mature. "It is good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn thy statutes" (Ps.119:71).

The body of Christ, the church, is organized and commissioned 5 times with its job; not to beg money, nor better society, nor drill wells, nor march on Washington; No,... It is to preach the gospel. America is laden with apostate churches that do not follow His Word and we are not to fellowship or unite with apostate churches. 2) There is to be a unity in Spirit. What The Bible Says Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice The Obadiah that did not write a prophecy book in the Bible was a governor of King Ahab's House; Ahab being the most vile, insolent, Baal worshiping king ever to sit on the throne of Israel. Obadiah causes muddy consternation; as do many Christians in our day. In a parentheses the word of God says Obadiah "feared the Lord greatly" (1Kings.18:3), but in his job description, and in his intercourse with God's Prophet Elijah, Obadiah was a completely compromised disciple.

He had a high ranking position in a vile, God-hating government; he was searching for resources that would keep his vile king in military power; and he was a "has-been" who had once known truth and done right. In addressing a Believer's new walk, in our new "vocation wherewith ye are called", Paul says, "But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ" (Eph 4:7). There is no mere measuring cup in this expression. It is not like he gives me a cup full of grace, gives you two cups full, and gives Joe Shmo five cups full. When God gives us grace, it is "according to the measure of the gift of Christ." That measure of grace is immeasurable, it is all sufficient, it is unmerited even by definition. Paul stated it earlier, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ" (Eph.1:3). The Psalmist states it similarly, "Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah" (Ps.68:19).

There is a similar expression in John 3:34, "For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him." In this context the Holy Ghost was not given to Christ a little bit at a time, … he had full and complete access. So it is for the Believer today, we have full access, that is why Jesus could say, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father" (John.14:12). I can be as filled with God's Spirit as Christ was, IF I'd open my life and let him in. So to for God's grace, IF I'd ASK (Ask, Seek, Knock), dip in and take all I need.

When describing the gifts given to men by God's grace, Paul adds an insightful parenthesis, "(Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth? 10 He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things)" (Eph.4:9-10). In verse 8, Paul is roughly quoting Psalm 68:18 (When you are an Apostle writing under inspiration you can roughly quote anything you want, others, not so), but in the parenthesis he is addressing what a mediator must be able to do, ascending up to God, and descending down to man. Job puts it, "For he is not a man, as I am, that I should answer him, and we should come together in judgment. 33 Neither is there any daysman betwixt us, that might lay his hand upon us both" (Job.9:32-33). This ascending and descending of the Son of man is intriguing. It shows up in our salvation in Romans 10, "... Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:) Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead)" (Rom.10:6-7). And again in John 3, "And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven" (John.3:13). And again in Agur's profound riddle, "Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?" (Prov.30:4). God did. That's profoundly intriguing.

If I listed the books here it would just be a cut and paste. My point is that Isaiah has sixty-six chapters, 39 in the old covenant, and 27 in the new covenant. That makes Isaiah chapter 40 the first chapter of the new covenant and marvelously it begins, "*Comfort ye, comfort ye, my people, saith your God*" (Isa.40:1). In the new covenant, there was to be a comforter! And there is! He is with us forever! (John.14:16). In the new covenant there was to be, "*The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, prepare ye the way of the LORD*" (Isa.40:3); John the Baptist did that! (Matt.3:3, Mark.1:3, Luke.3:4, John.1:6).

The voice cried "all flesh is grass... The spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it, ... The grass withereth..." (Isa.40:6–8), and "the word was made flesh... And while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (John.1:14, Rom.5:8). Zion and Jerusalem, where to lift up their voice with strength, and bring good tidings (Isa.40:9); and the church is commissioned to preach that gospel to every creature (Matt.28:14– 28, Mark.16:15, Luke.24:46–48, John.20:21, Acts.1:8).

What The Bible Says Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice When a Pastor fails in leadership, he becomes simply a church caretaker. When he wearies of that, he becomes a church undertaker. That is all too common in these post-COVID perilous times we live in. To stay off that trek Pastor Clark, at a 2023 NE Vision Summit,

gave seven things a minister must keep alive and viable. First, never lose your **vision**, your dream, your goals in the ministry. Keep them active, updated, alive, and current. Up front the apostle Paul writes to Timothy, "*I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry*" (1Tim.1:12). Word the reason you are in the ministry, a ministry of reconciliation, and give thanks you are in it.

Elijah called down fire from heaven, never lose the **fire** of ministry. "*His word was in my heart as a burning fire … Is not my word like a fire?*" (Jer.20:9, 23:29). Never lose the **"awe"** of ministry, nor the **zeal** of ministry. "*The joy of the Lord is your strength… I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth*"; never lose the **joy** of ministry (Neh.8:10, 3John.1:4).

Don't lose the **love** of the ministry or your love in the ministry: love people, love souls, love being a minister of reconciliation (2Cor.5:18). Don't lose your **burden** of ministry. The Old Testament closes with, "*The burden of the word of the LORD to Israel by Malachi*"; the New Testament opens with "*My yoke is easy, and my burden is light*" (Matt.11:30); preach the gospel, be a soul winner. You might get weary "in" the ministry, but these seven things can help that you never get weary "of" the ministry; "*in due season we shall reap, if we faint not*" (Gal.6:9).

# Msg #2332 Logistics, Locations, and Lights

Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice The hand of God left Gideon camped beside the well of Harod with three hundred men and a host of logistic problems (Judg.7:1-6). While sending all the rest of Israel every man unto his tent, and retaining those three hundred men (vr.8), I would have used Amazon to order up three-hundred empty pitchers and cute little oil lamps; "Lets try for overnight delivery." Truth is, the three hundred came with their own food and trumpets and Gideon scrounged up empty pitchers and lamps. Joe Shmo said, "Why did I get this grubby ugly water hauling pitcher, and Dr. Capable over there has that ornate, gold trimmed, up for show pitcher?" Gideon responds, "Never mind the type of empty pitcher you have, it is just an empty pitcher, and it is to be broken anyway!" Joe goes on with his lament, "Well, why do I have to stand up on the edge of this obscure steep hillside while I. M. Somebody gets to guard that roadway towards the main mountain pass?" Gideon responds, "Those grasshoppers need to be completely surrounded by light, never mind the empty pitcher type, never mind the obscure location you are at, just break your pitcher, hold up the Light, and sound off with your trumpet!"

Break your vessel where God puts you, hold up the Light where you are at, sound out on that trumpet that you have, blast it as long and as hard as you can, and let God do his perfect work. Obedience is the very best way, to show that you believe. I have often left a conference, come to our two story, 100 max occupancy brick school house, and felt a twinge of discouragement. Pastor Shirley's parting NE Vision Summit message on Gideon, completely alleviated that tendency on 27 July.

What The Bible Savs Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice Believing in the Bible's verbal inspiration, inerrancy, and infallibility requires believing God's account of his six-day creation and the seventh day of rest. Accepting any minute shred of man's evolutionary hypothesis requires that God's Holy Word is somehow deceptive. On Sunday, the first day of this universe's existence, God created, out of nothing, a finite time, space, and matter continuum. He carefully words that in the first sentence of the Holy Bible. All three continua have three dimensions, are inner dependent, and must coexist. The "earth" or "dirt" was not a planet, it was without form. He also reveals that this "matter" was void of all visible construct. massive, and dark, in his second sentence. The formless, void, dark, mass of matter, takes on form, i.e. hydrogen atoms clinging to oxygen atoms with covalent bonds of energy, when "the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters."

# בְּרֵאשָׁית בָּרָא אֱלֹהֵים אַת הַשָּׁמַיִם וְאַת הָאֶרָץ:

The first seven words of the Holy Bible declare that, in a finite time continuum, God created a finite space continuum, and a finite matter continuum. The three finite continua are interdependent and interconnected, and, consequently, were created together, and they only exist together. The three continua are per se three dimensional with time's past, present and future, space's up, north and east, and matter's solid, liquid and gas.

In error modernist ecumenical "scholars" suppose that God created the heavens, plural, because their small finite minds have discerned three of them; where birds fly, where stars fly, and where God sits. In their modernist ecumenical copyright bibles they put in what they suppose God meant to say, with heaven plural instead of singular. They even try to justify their twisting of this verse by saying, "In the Hebrew, the word for 'heaven' is plural."

In error they also suppose that "*the earth*" in this verse is a planet; yet God does not make planet Earth until the third day (Gen.1:9).

Do not be deceived by these modernist ecumenical "scholars". In this verse both heaven, and God, are in the singular, even though they are masculine plural Hebrew nouns. One needs to learn a little Hebrew to unravel their lie and see how they twist Scripture.

In Hebrew, and often in English, whether a noun is plural or singular is determined by vowel sounds; i.e. men vs man. But the Hebrew alphbet has no visible vowels, standardized vowel markings were added to the manuscripts in the 4<sup>th</sup> century AD. The preacher that says heaven is plural in the Hebrew text does not know what he is saying. Heaven and God are plural nouns because they end in "ym". In Hebrew masculine singular nouns have no special endings, but plural (2 or more) nouns end with <code>r'</code> (i ym) and the dual (2 only, no more) nouns end with <code>r'</code> (ai ym). Notice here that even the plural and dual nouns are only differentiated by vowel markings (the ending proceeded by an "i" sound vs an "ai" sound).

In God's first sentence, one would have no more cause to make heaven plural, than to make God plural, i.e. "In the beginning gods created the heavens." Just because *Elohim* (God) is a plural noun, that does not mean it is used in the plural every time it is used by God (*Elohim*). And just because *Shamayim* (Heaven) is a plural-dual noun, that does not mean it is used in the plural every time it is used by God (*Elohim*). Indeed, every time *Shamayin* (Heaven) is used in Genesis 1 it is used in the singular; the first occurrence of *Shamayin* (Heaven) in the plural occurs in Genesis 2:1, "*Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them*." In the Hebrew Bible it is then used in the plural in 107 other verses. They are so translated in the Authorized King James Bible. It is anybodies guess what you'll get in any modernist ecumenical copyright bible.

So, when God said,

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

## Msg #2334 In the Beginning God, Day 2 - Monday

God's Monday of creation does not invoke a lot of excitement in many people. In his Sunday account God used seven Hebrew words to tell how he made three-dimensional time, space, and matter out of nothing. Now on Monday all he does is insert a firmament between two layers of water! Monday is the only day of creation with no "It was good" exclamation. This so depressed Scofield and Larkin that they force-fit a gargantuan gap of geological fiction to account for their imagined age of rocks! In the Holy Bible God means what he says, and says what he means. On Monday there are no rocks, ... only water. And now there is a "firmament" between the water above and the water below. "Firmament" is an interesting matter, and "Matter" is an interesting thing. Daniel Webster's 1828 describes firmament well, and high school chemistry describes matter well. A dome or region of expanse, is used 17 times in the Hebrew and King-James Bible; five times on God's Monday! It behooves a Bible student to research them all.

What The Bible Says Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice The visions of Daniel explained in his seventh chapter capture all seven of the upcoming world kingdoms: Babylon, Persia, Greece, Rome, Revived Roman, The Abomination of Desolation, and Messianic Kingdom. All are written in a revelation where Daniel was given "the truth of all this ... and the interpretation of the things" (Dan.7:16). Consequently, in Bible imagery "beasts" are empowered men, who rule world empires. The careful student of Bible prophecy knows some things about the Revived Roman Empire and it's "ten horns" (Dan.7:7,20,24, Rev.12:3, 13:1, 17:3,7,12,16). These ten horns are the ten toes destroyed by the "Stone cut out without hands" (Dan.2:34-35,42-44). Nebuchadnezzar's dream about the toes, recorded in Daniel 2, "is certain and the interpretation thereof sure" (2:45).

Good Samaritan's Penny Pulpit by Pastor Ed Rice The Revelation of Jesus Christ is not allegorical, it is sometimes metaphorical, but God says what he means and means what he says. The accounts of the seven seals, the seven trumpets, and the seven vials are intermittently interrupted with what have been called seven parentheticals. The last one describes a great whore riding on a scarlet colored beast (17:1-4). Britannica says ancient Rome was the city built on seven hills, and that accords with "the seven mountains on which the woman sitteth" (17:9). The Holy Roman Catholic Church herself (which is not holy nor catholic), trying to claim Peter's first epistle addressed Rome, and Peter as their first pope, they, ignorant of the Revelation of Jesus Christ, ironically assigned themselves the title "Mystery Babylon." However the shoe-fits, the woman is a one world religion, and the beast, a one world government. The beast is the abomination of desolation (Mat.24:15, Rev.13:1-2). The ten kings which "have one mind and shall give their power and strength unto the beast"(17:13), "these shall hate the whore and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire. For God hath put in their hearts to fulfill his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled (17:16-17).

The greatly beloved Daniel understood by books that the seventyyear Babylonian captivity was closing, he prayed, and Gabriel came to him to give him "*skill and understanding*" (Dan.9:22). Gabriel said, "*Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people* (Israel) *and upon thy holy city* (Jerusalem)" (9:21-24). A Bible student discerns that these are weeks-of-years, that sixty-nine of them are accounted for in verses 25-26, and that the "one week" spoken of in verse 27 is a seven year period wherein there "*shall be great tribulation, such as was not seen from the beginning of the world*" (Matt.24:21). Further in verse 27 it is clear that the "he" that "*shall make it desolate*" is the abomination of desolation of Matt.24:15, the beast to rise up out of the sea of Rev.13:1, AND the scarlet colored beast, full of names of blasphemy of Rev.17:3. "He" shall make war with the Lamb, and we know how that will end (Rev.19).

What Gabriel said would be done for Israel and Jerusalem after seventy-weeks is critical: 1) to finish the transgression. 2) to make an end of sin, 3) to make reconciliation for iniquity, 4) to bring in everlasting righteousness, 5) to seal up the vision and prophecy, and 6) to anoint the most Holy.

When the apostle John writes in the Revelation of Jesus Christ "*the things which shall be here after*" (1:19, cf. Chap.4-19) it is all about Israel and their 70th week. Miss that and you are missing the heart of Biblical prophecy, and the heart of God. When a church misses that, they are apostate. Israel is presently in a war of Biblical proportion, those siding with Hamas or Palestinians are pitted directly against the LORD God of Israel. And we know how that will end.
